## Durgesh Aranya Zoological Park to Receive IGBC Certification

- **Durgesh Aranya Zoological Park** in **Himachal Pradesh** will be the **first zoo in India** to receive certification from the **Indian Green Building Council (IGBC)**.
- The **IGBC certification** recognizes the park's commitment to **sustainability** and **environmental standards**.

### About Indian Green Building Council (IGBC)



- It is a part of the **Confederation of Indian Industry (CII)**, was established in **2001**.
- IGBC provides **green building rating programs, certification services, and training programs**.
- The **IGBC headquarters** is located in **Hyderabad**.

---

## Ayodhya Sets Two Guinness World Records During Deepotsav 2024

- **Ayodhya** made history during **Deepotsav 2024** with two **Guinness World Records**..
- The event was organized by the **Uttar Pradesh Tourism Department** along with the **district administration**.

### The World Records



1. **World's Largest Display of Oil Lamps:** More than **2.5 Lakh diyas** were lit along the banks of the **Saryu River**.
2. **Most People Performing Diya Rotation Simultaneously:** Thousands participated in this traditional ritual

---

## India Hosts First Asian Buddhist Summit in New Delhi

- **India** is hosting the **first-ever Asian Buddhist Summit (ABS)** in **New Delhi**.
- The **2024 theme** is **“Role of Buddha Dhamma in Strengthening Asia”**.
- The event is organized by the **Ministry of Culture** and the **International Buddhist Confederation (IBC)**.
- The summit aims to explore how **Buddha Dhamma** can promote **peace and spiritual development** across **Asia**.

### About International Buddhist Confederation (IBC)



- **IBC** is the **largest religious Buddhist confederation** globally.
- In **November 2011**, New Delhi hosted the **Global Buddhist Congregation (GBC)**, leading to the establishment of the **International Buddhist Confederation**.
- The **IBC headquarters** is located in **Delhi, India**.

---

## India Submits Bid to Host 2036 Summer Olympics

- **India** has formally submitted its bid to host the **2036 Summer Olympics** through a **Letter of Intent** from the **Indian Olympic Association (IOA)** to the **IOC**.
- The **IOC's Future Host Commission** will oversee the selection process.
- The **141st IOC Session** was held in **Mumbai**, where **Prime Minister Modi** emphasized India's commitment to organizing the Olympics in 2036.

### About International Olympic Committee



- The **IOC** was founded by **Pierre de Coubertin** in **1894**, marking the revival of the ancient Olympic Games.
- The **IOC** is the supreme authority in overseeing the organization of both **Summer and Winter Olympics**.
- The **IOC headquarters** is in **Lausanne, Switzerland**
- It operates under the **Olympic Charter**, which governs the Olympic Movement.
- **Thomas Bach** has been the **IOC president** since **2013**.

### About Olympic Games



- The **first Olympic Games** were held in **Athens** in **1896**, and the games have been held every **four years** since then.
- The **Olympic flag** was created in **1913** under the suggestion of **Baron Pierre de Coubertin**.
- During the **1928 Amsterdam Games**, the **Olympic flame** was ceremonially lit and burned in a giant torch.
- The Olympic motto is "**Citius Altius Fortius**" (**Faster, Higher, Stronger**).

---

## Shilp Samagam Mela 2024 Promotes Artisans at Dilli Haat, New Delhi

- The **Union Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment** organized the **Shilp Samagam Mela 2024** at **Dilli Haat, New Delhi**.
- The event aims to empower **marginalized artisans** by providing a marketplace for their crafts.

### Key Initiatives Launched



- **TULIP (Traditional Artisans' Upliftment Livelihood Programme):** A digital e-marketing platform designed to empower **marginalized artisans**.
- **Rang Paridhan Program:** Showcases **artisan-made uniforms** for the Ministry's corporations.

---

## PM-Vidyalaxmi Scheme: Financial Support for Meritorious Students

- The **PM-Vidyalaxmi scheme** was approved by the **Union Cabinet**.
- It aims to provide **financial support** to meritorious students seeking **higher education**.

### About PM-Vidyalaxmi



- The scheme offers **collateral-free** and **guarantor-free loans** for students enrolling in top **860 Quality Higher Education Institutions (QHEIs)** across India.
- Students can avail loans up to **₹7.5 lakh**, with a **75% credit guarantee** for defaults.
- The scheme prioritizes **students from government institutions** pursuing **technical and professional courses**.
- A unified portal, '**PM-Vidyalaxmi**', will facilitate loan applications and interest subvention.

---

## India Signs Host Country Agreement with Global Biofuels Alliance (GBA)

- **India** has signed the **Host Country Agreement (HCA)** with the **Global Biofuels Alliance (GBA)**.
- The agreement enables **GBA** to establish its **Secretariat in India**.

### About Global Biofuels Alliance



- The **Global Biofuels Alliance** promotes the use of **biofuels** as a **cleaner, climate-friendly** alternative to **fossil fuels**.
- **GBA** includes **27 member countries** and **12 international organizations** like the **World Bank**, **World Economic Forum**, and **International Energy Agency**.
- **GBA** was launched in **2023** by **Prime Minister Narendra Modi** along with leaders of **eight other countries** during **India's G20 Presidency**.
- **GBA** focuses on **second-generation (2G) ethanol** made from **agricultural waste**, **used cooking oil**, and **processed animal byproducts**.

## Generations of Biofuels



- **First Generation:** Made from **edible biomass** like **sugar, starch, vegetable oil, or animal fats**.
- **Second Generation:** Derived from **non-edible biomass** like **agricultural and forest residues** or dedicated biofuel crops.
- **Third Generation:** Produced from **aquatic biomass** like **algae**.
- **Fourth Generation:** Made from **engineered plants and microorganisms**.

---

## MSDE Reconstitutes CAC to Enhance Apprenticeship Training

- The **Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE)** has **reconstituted the Central Apprenticeship Council (CAC)** to strengthen apprenticeship training.
- The **new CAC** includes **54 members**, up from **46** in the previous council.
- **MSDE Minister Jayant Chaudhary** will chair the reconstituted CAC.

### About Central Apprenticeship Council (CAC)



- It was established under the **Apprenticeship Act, 1961**.
- The CAC acts as a **statutory advisory body** to guide the **central government** on apprenticeship policies.
- The reconstituted CAC, with a **three-year mandate**, aims to **expand apprenticeship opportunities** and support **workforce development**.

---

## Government Launches Scheme to Strengthen Medical Device Industry in India

- The **Government of India** launched the **Scheme for Strengthening the Medical Device Industry**.
- The scheme aims to **boost the medical device sector** and promote **self-reliance in medical devices**.
- Focus areas include addressing **infrastructure gaps**, reducing **import dependency** & to **develop a skilled workforce**.

### Draft 'Drug, Medical Devices, and Cosmetics Bill-2022'



- The **Union Health Ministry** released the draft bill in 2022.
- This Bill aims to **replace the Drugs and Cosmetics Act of 1940** with an updated regulatory framework.
- It introduces **stricter regulatory guidelines** & a **regulatory body** specifically for **medical devices**.
- A **new definition for medical devices** has been proposed.
- It aims to **expand and strengthen regulation** over the **import of medical devices** into India.

---

### Union Ministry Doubles Fines on Stubble Burning to Combat Air Pollution

- Under the **Environment Protection Act (EPA) of 1986**, the **Union Ministry of Environment, Forest, and Climate Change** has **doubled the fines on stubble burning**.
- This measure aims to **reduce stubble burning** and address **poor air quality** in **Delhi** and surrounding regions.
- Penalties are implemented through the **Commission for Air Quality Management (CAQM) Act of 2021**.
- The **regulations apply to Delhi, Punjab, Haryana, and NCR regions** in **Rajasthan and Uttar Pradesh**.
- **Fines collected** go to **State Pollution Control Boards or Committees**.

### Commission for Air Quality Management in NCR Bill, 2021



- The Bill establishes a **Commission** to improve **co-ordination, research, and problem-solving** for **air quality issues** in the **National Capital Region (NCR)** and nearby areas.
- **Adjoining areas** include **Haryana, Punjab, Rajasthan, and Uttar Pradesh**.
- Violating the Bill's provisions may lead to **imprisonment of up to five years, a fine of up to one crore rupees, or both**.
- **Farmers are exempt** from criminal prosecution; the **CAQM** can instead **levy environmental compensation** on them.



# STATE

## Supreme Court Issues Guidelines to Eradicate Child Marriage in Rajasthan by 2030

- The **Supreme Court** issued guidelines to **eliminate child marriages** in **Rajasthan** by **2030**.
- The **Prohibition of Child Marriage Act (PCMA), 2006** is to be enforced without any exceptions from **personal laws**.

### About Prohibition of Child Marriage Act (PCMA), 2006



- The **PCMA** defines **child marriage** as one where the **girl is under 18 years** or the **boy is under 21 years**.
- The **PCMA** came into effect on **1st November 2007**, replacing the **Child Marriage Restraint Act (CMRA) of 1929** or **Sharda Act**.

### About Child Marriage Restraint Act, 1929



- The act was also known as the **Sharda Act**, as it was sponsored by **Harbilas Sharda**.
- The original **Sharda Act** set the **marriage age at 14 for girls** and **18 for boys**.
- This was later **amended in 1978** to **18 years for girls** and **21 years for boys**.

---

## Andhra Pradesh Launches Deepam 2.0 to Empower Women with Free Clean Cooking Energy

- The **Andhra Pradesh government** has launched the **Deepam 2.0** scheme.
- The scheme aims to **empower women** by providing **free access to clean cooking energy**.
- Under **Deepam 2.0**, women will receive **three free gas cylinders per year**.

### About Pradhan Mantri Ujjwala Yojana (PMUY)



- It was introduced by the **Ministry of Petroleum and Natural Gas (MOPNG)** in **May 2016**.
- **PMUY** aims to **replace traditional cooking fuels** with **cleaner LPG** in **rural and deprived households**.
- The flagship **PMUY** scheme targeted the **release of 8 Crore LPG connections** to **deprived households** by **March 2020**.

## Madhya Pradesh Approves 35% Reservation for Women in State Government Jobs

- The **Madhya Pradesh cabinet** approved a **35% reservation for women** in all **state government recruitments**.

### Recent Related News



- The **Karnataka government** has mandated **33% reservation for women** in **outsourced government services**.
- **Karnataka** is the **first state in India** to provide **1% reservation for the transgender community** in all **government services**.

## Madhya Pradesh & Rajasthan Form Joint Corridor Management Committee for Cheetahs

- A **joint corridor management committee** has been established between **Madhya Pradesh** and **Rajasthan**.
- This committee was formed in response to **cheetahs from Madhya Pradesh straying into Rajasthan**.
- The primary task of the committee is to **identify a 'Cheetah Conservancy Landscape'** in the corridor to ensure **safe movement of cheetahs** between the two states.

### About Project Cheetah



- **Project Cheetah** is the world's first **inter-continental large wild carnivore translocation project**.
- The project aims to restore the **cheetah population** in India, where they were declared extinct in **1952**.
- The project is implemented by the **National Tiger Conservation Authority (NTCA)** in collaboration with the **Madhya Pradesh Forest Department** and the **Wildlife Institute of India (WII)**.
- **Phase 1** involves the translocation of **8 & 12 cheetahs** from **Namibia** and **South Africa** respectively to **Kuno National Park**.
- **Phase 2** is considering sourcing cheetahs from **Kenya** to **Kuno National Park** and **Gandhi Sagar Wildlife Sanctuary** in **Madhya Pradesh**.

## Uttarakhand Foundation Day: Celebrating 24 Years of Statehood

- **Uttarakhand Foundation Day**, also known as **Uttarakhand Diwas**, is celebrated annually on **November 9**.
- **2024** marks the **24th anniversary** of Uttarakhand's formation.
- **Uttarakhand** was established as **India's 27th state** in **2000** after being carved out of northern **Uttar Pradesh**.

## About Uttarakhand



- Originally called **Uttaranchal**, the state's name was changed to **Uttarakhand** in **2007**.
  - Uttarakhand shares **international boundaries** with **China (Tibet)** in the north and **Nepal** in the east.
  - Known as the “**Land of the Gods (Devbhumi)**”.
  - **Bhararisain** serves as the **summer capital**, while **Dehradun** is the **winter capital**.
  - **Pushkar Singh Dhami** is the current **Chief Minister**.

produce **titanium slag** in **Odisha**.

- The collaboration aims to convert **low-grade ilmenite** into **high-grade feedstock** for titanium production.
- **UKTMP JSC** will provide the technology to produce **titanium slag**, while **IREL** will supply **ilmenite** from its Odisha operations.

#### About Titanium



- **Titanium** is a **chemical element** with the symbol **Ti** and atomic number **22**.
- **Titanium** is as strong as steel but weighs about **half** as much.
- **Ilmenite** is the most important ore for **titanium production**.
- It is resistant to corrosion in **seawater**, **aqua regia**, and **chlorine**.
- It was discovered by **William Gregor** in **1791**.
- Titanium is also referred to as the **metal of hope**.

---

### Royal Enfield Unveils New Electric Vehicle Brand “Flying Flea”

- **Royal Enfield** has introduced its electric vehicle (EV) brand named “**Flying Flea**”.
- The original **Flying Flea** was a compact, lightweight motorcycle created in the **1940s** for **military use** during **World War II**.

#### About Royal Enfield



- **Royal Enfield** is the **oldest motorcycle brand** in continuous production globally.
- **Eicher Motors** is the parent organization of Royal Enfield.
- The **headquarters** of Royal Enfield is located in **Chennai, Tamil Nadu**.

- The **Indian government** signed a **\$200 million loan agreement** with the **Asian Development Bank (ADB)**.

- India's target aligns with the **Kunming-Montreal Global Biodiversity Framework (KM-GBF)**, aiming to **halt biodiversity loss by 2030**.
- A **National Biodiversity Strategy and Action Plan** outlines strategies to **conserve and use biodiversity sustainably**.

### About Convention on Biological Diversity (CBD)



- CBD promotes biodiversity conservation
- It was adopted in **1992 at the UN Conference** in **Rio de Janeiro, Brazil**.
- India became a **CBD member in 1994**
- The **CBD Secretariat** is based in **Montreal, Canada**.

## CWC Report Highlights 10.81% Increase in Himalayan Glacial Lakes

- A **Central Water Commission (CWC)** report reveals a **10.81% increase** in the area of **glacial lakes and water bodies** in the **Himalayan region** from **2011 to 2024**.
- **Climate change** is the primary factor driving this expansion, raising concerns over **glacial lake outburst floods (GLOFs)**.
- Significant expansions were noted in **Ladakh, Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand, Sikkim, and Arunachal Pradesh**.

### About Glacial Lakes



- **Glacial lakes** form from **meltwater filling depressions** left behind by **receding glaciers**.
- Recently, a **GLOF event** from **South Lhonak Lake** in **northwestern Sikkim** caused extensive destruction.

## IMF Releases AI Preparedness Index Assessing 174 Countries

- The **AI Preparedness Index (APII)** was released by the **IMF (International Monetary Fund)**.
- The index assesses the level of **AI preparedness** across **174 countries**.

- **Singapore** ranks **first** with a score of **0.80**, excelling in **AI capabilities** and **workforce adaptability**.
- **India** ranks **72** out of **174 countries**, with an **AI Preparedness Index** rating of **0.49**.

## Henley Passport Index 2024: Singapore Tops, India Ranks 83rd

- In the **2024 Henley Passport Index**, **Singapore** holds the top position as the world's most powerful passport, with **visa-free access to 195 countries**.
- **India** ranks **83rd**, allowing **visa-free access to 58 countries** for its citizens.
- The **Henley Passport Index** is published by **Henley & Partners**, a **United Kingdom-based immigration consultancy**.

#### About Henley Passport Index



- The index was created by **Dr. Christian H. Kaelin** and launched in **2006**.
- The rankings are based on exclusive data from the **International Air Transport Association (IATA)**, which has the **largest database of travel information**.
- The **Henley Passport Index** includes a total of **199 different passports**.
- The index ranks passports based on **visa-free access**, **diplomatic relations**, and **international agreements**.

## Luxembourg Tops Nature Conservation Index 2024; India Ranks 176th

- In the **Nature Conservation Index (NCI) 2024**, **Luxembourg** ranks **first** with a score of **70.8** out of **100** for its **natural habitat and wildlife preservation**.
- **India** ranks **176th** with a score of **45.5** in conservation efforts.

  4. **Future trends**
- The index uses data from the **World Bank** and the **International Union for Conservation of Nature (IUCN)**.
